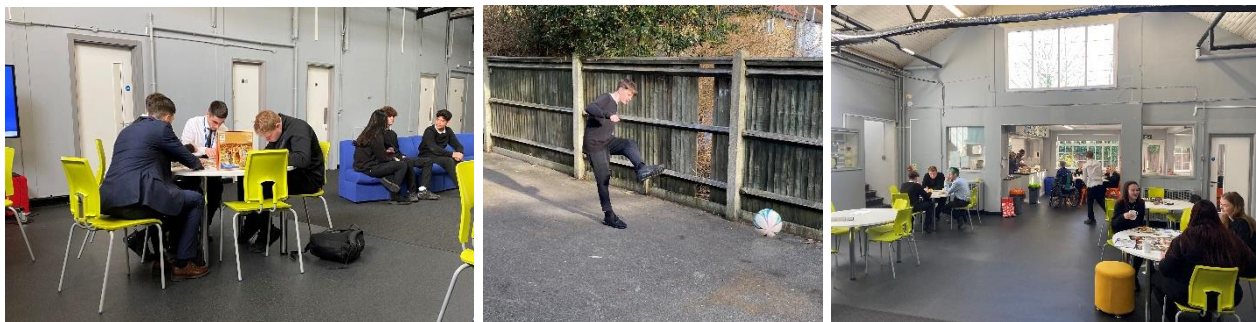
The start of the day also allows pupils to see whether they have achieved a place on the "recognition board" from the previous day!
